

## Two Masters in Chemistry students cleared NET with JRF (Dec 2018)



Two students from Department of Chemistry, Sri Guru Granth Sahib World University (SGGSWU), Fatehgarh Sahib have secured 102 (Harpal) and 133 (Rupinder Kaur) rank at all-India level in the national level eligibility test (NET-JRF) conducted by CSIR-UGC, New Delhi in December 2018. They have done their masters in Chemistry (M.Sc.) from Sri Guru Granth Sahib World University, Batch 2016-18. Rupinder belongs to Village Lehragaga, Dist. Sangrur and Harpal is from Ludhiana.
