

SYLLABUS OF MASTERS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION
M.P.Ed. (TWO YEAR) SEMESTER SYSTEM
From 2019-20 onwards

1. ORDINANCES

The M.P.Ed (Masters of Physical Education) is a teacher education course and shall be of two year duration (four Semesters). Candidates shall appear in the final examination at the end of each semester.

2. REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSION

Norms and standards prescribed by NCTE /UGC/State Government or any other competent body for admission to M.P.Ed. Course shall be followed. The nature of M.P.Ed course is such that it involves vigorous physical activity as such physically handicapped persons are not allowed to take admission in this course. It is also compulsory for the women candidates to sign an undertaking that they will discontinue the course at once if they get pregnant during the course of study.

3. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:-

Admission to M.P.Ed course shall be done on the basis of Entrance test, which will consist of:-

- 1.1 Physical fitness test.
- 1.2 Basic Academic Qualification
- 1.3. Sports achievements.
- 1.4 Interview
- 1.5 Co-Curricular activities (NSS, NCC, and Others)


Every candidate shall be required to appear in Physical Fitness Test, as per events mentioned*. Candidates failing in Physical Fitness Test shall not be considered for admission.

4. Admission Criteria for M.P.Ed (Two Year)

4.1 Physical Fitness Test (Qualifying Pass Percentage = 50%)

Events of the physical Fitness test are as follow:

Total	100 marks


Note: - The merit for admission will be prepared on the basis of Marks obtained from the total of 100 marks of Basic Educational Qualification, Sports Achievements, Co-Curricular activities (NSS, NCC, and Others) and Interview.

5. Interview

Each candidate should appear in front of the Interview panel, framed by the Worthy Vice Chancellor to take admission in the MPED 2 Year Course.

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General Guidelines:-

1. The in-service candidates are required to submit "No Objection Certificate" from the employers.
2. The candidate seeking admission to the course should be medically fit. In addition to furnishing a medical certificate, he/she shall have to undergo a medical and physical examination by the University Medical Officer on the basis of which his/her admission shall be decided. A married woman will be required to furnish certificate to the effect that she is not already pregnant and shall undertake not to go in for pregnancy during the course of her studies.
3. Participation at National Level competition should be supported by other sports certificates.
4. The students of M.P.Ed are required to wear uniforms for practical classes as prescribed by the Board of studies.
5. Physical Fitness Test shall be conducted by the committee framed by the University.
6. All the candidates are required to bring original certificates at the time of counselling.
